

Show Rules and information:

- Cross-entering between walk/jog and walk/jog/lope classes is allowed; however, it disqualifies exhibitors from high point awards. Riders must participate in Showmanship, English, Western and Bareback classes to be eligible for high point awards.
- All judges' decisions are final
- Schooling (Not being judged) only allowed in non-pattern classes, please see box on entry form page for list of eligible schooling classes.
- Jackpot Warm up class: \$3 at the gate to enter, 50% payback, random drawing at end of class determines the winner. Must wear exhibitor number to enter. Riders will be asked to walk, jog or trot, and reverse.
- Show clothes are not required. Proper RIDING boots are required to participate in any event. Helmets are required for riders under 18 during all mounted classes.
- Novice Rider: 1st or 2nd year of showing and may not have won more than 3 blue ribbons in any prior performance shows, riders cannot switch to non-novice classes to qualify for awards.
- Walk Only, Pee Wee Rider Class – Riders 9 & Under, may ride on their own or on a lead line
- **Adding or dropping a class must be done a minimum of 3 classes prior to change, forms provided at desk.**
- Contestant's age is the age they were on January 1 of the current year or actual age if rider prefers.
- The Judge and Show Management have the right to dismiss any unruly, uncontrolled or lame Contestant or Horse. Horses deemed to be unsafe for any reason will be asked to leave with no refund.
- Show Management reserves the right to combine or cancel a class if there are less than 3 entries
- ALL dogs must be on a LEASH at all times, all messes must be cleaned up by pet's owner.
- Do not tie your horses to the wooden fence in the parking lot.
- Speed limit is 10 miles per hour
- No running horses on the track during the show.
- \$25 Fee for all returned checks.
- Training and/or schooling equipment permitted, but may be penalized at the discretion of the judge
- Stallions handled by exhibitors 18 and Over only
- Please pick up any garbage/loose hay/and horse manure in the parking lot prior to leaving
- Parents or guardian must assume responsibility for their children and horses, guardian must be available at all times during the show
- No Refunds for scratched entries, refunds for other reasons decided upon by show management, admin fee will not be refunded in any case.
- Gate hold requests must be made a minimum of 2 classes in advance.
- No horses in picnic/playground area.
- We ask that riders please compete in the category that truly reflects their experience/level of riding.
