- Cross-entering between classes is allowed. Riders must participate in both English, Western and showmanship classes to be eligible for high point awards.
- If you are entering both Walk/Trot and Walk/Trot/Cantor classes, you must declare which high point category you are competing for at registration.
- All judges' decisions are FINAL.
- Hi Point and Hi Point reserve will only be awarded if a minimum of 3 competitors are competing.
- Classes with fewer than 3 riders will be cancelled or combined at managements discretion.
- All gaming events when applicable will conform to WAHSET pattern standards.
- Show clothes are not required. Proper RIDING boots are required to participate in any event. Helmets are required for riders under 18 during all mounted classes.
- Riders must wear long pants, boots, Not allowed – sweats, halter tops, swim wear, spaghetti straps, tube tops. All kinds of hats are optional.
- All riders must have a signed waiver within the previous year before entering arena.
- All Trail Course Classes: only two balks per obstacle are allowed, rider must then move to next obstacle.
- Novice/Green: 1st or 2nd year of showing and may not have won more than 3 blue ribbons in any prior performance shows, riders cannot switch to non-novice classes to qualify for awards.
- Walk Only, Pee Wee Rider Class – Riders 9 & Under, May ride on their own or on a leadline
- All class changes must be made prior to show start time. All changes made after show start must be made 3 classes prior and a fee of \$5 is required per change.
- The arena is for riders only. There will be no chairs, parents, trainers, etc. in the arena during show time.
- Contestant's age is the age they were on January 1 of the current year or actual age if rider prefers.
- The Judge and Show Management have the right to dismiss any unruly or uncontrolled Contestant or Horse. Horses deemed to be unsafe for any reason will be asked to leave with no refund.
- Do not tie your horses to the wooden fence in the parking lot.
- Speed limit is 10 miles per hour

- No running horses on the track during the show.
- \$25 Fee for all returned checks.
- Training and/or schooling equipment permitted, but may be penalized at the discretion of the judge
- Stallions handled by exhibitors 18 and Over only

- Horses hauled in and shown from their trailers are responsible for cleaning up after themselves. Bring a shovel or pitchfork to clean up your mess if you show out of your trailer.
- ALL dogs must be on a LEASH at all times, all messes must be cleaned up by pet's owner.
- Parents or guardian must assume responsibility for their children and horses, guardian must be available at all times during the show
- No Refunds for scratched entries, refunds for other reasons decided upon by show management, admin/ haul-in fee will not be refunded in any case.
- Gate hold requests must be made a minimum of 2 classes in advance.
- No horses in picnic/playground area.
- We ask that riders please compete in the category that truly reflects their experience/level of riding.
- Barn and paddock aisle way is for boarders only.
